PENALTY RATE FOR ARREARS &/OR LATE PAYMENTS-1.25% per month
PAY YOUR TAXES ON-LINE, TELPAY, INTERNET – CHECK WITH YOUR BANK

STATEMENT & DEMAND FOR TAXES: Current taxes are due and payable at par until **SEPTEMBER 29, 2025**. PENALTY of 1.25% per month will be added to current taxes on September 30th and on the first day of each month thereafter until paid or at the time of the tax sale. Penalties have been added on all arrears shown on tax statement to May 15, 2025. Payments made after May 15, 2025 are not reflected on the enclosed Statements. Arrears shown on your tax bill are subject to further penalties of 1.25% per month. Failure to receive a Statement and Demand for Taxes does not excuse an owner from responsibility for payment of taxes nor relieves the owner from liability for any late payment penalties. Monies should be in Canadian Funds. **Post-dated** and **installment** cheques are accepted. **Arrangements have been made with many financial institutions to allow payment of taxes to be paid electronically (Telpay, internet banking).** Please note that tax payments can now be made through RBC. Check with your bank or this office for more information.

TAX SALE: All lands in arrears for more than one year will be sold at the 2024 Tax Sale. **ALL TAX SALES ARE FINAL AT THE TIME OF PUBLIC AUCTION.** There is no redemption period once the auction has taken place.

PROVINCIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS: The Education Property Tax Credit Advance Program (EPTCA) is being replaced by the Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit (HATC) which will have a maximum credit amount of \$1,500. – Farmland School Tax Rebate Program – 50%.

BOARD OF REVISION: The 2026 Board of Revision date has been set for November 6th, 2025. Appeals must be received by October 21, 2025. Appeal forms are available at the RM Office.

AGGREGATE FEES: Transporting and mining of aggregate within the Rural Municipality of Rosser requires a license and payment of appropriate fees. Please contact the office for further information.

ENFORCEMENT (including DOG CONTROL): The Rural Municipality of Rosser has contracted with Rockwood Woodlands By-law Enforcement & Animal Control to enforce municipal by-law.
